do when your Horse/Tack/Trailer is
stolen!

Rod Vilencia is an advocate for people who find themselves victims of horse theft – especially "civil theft" that occurs when purchasing or selling a horse.

A horse trainer for 17 years, Rod is also experienced as a victim of horse theft. His own horse was stolen – and found 11 years later! He worked with the Sheriff's Dept. and the District Attorney to help him recover possession of his horse. Now he is a volunteer with Stolen Horse International Inc., a non-profit advocacy organization and their website, netposse.com. Rod will discuss: Permanent Identification of horses (there's more to it than you may think!); his own story of loss and recovery of his horse and how he now helps others recover their stolen horses; and how Stolen Horse International operates and how this network of volunteers assists individuals and law enforcement across the country in the recovery of stolen horses.
